EQUIPMENT

(1) Alarm Intrusion Panel x 1



Master Control with Wireless Receiver and Built-in Siren

A security system starts with a control panel. Usually located in a closet or a basement, the control panel contains the "brains" of the security system, and essentially operates as a central computer. Various sensors connect to the control panel from locations throughout your home. If your security system is armed and the sensors detect a problem, they send signals to the control panel. The control panel automatically dials the central monitoring station where the proper authorities are notified. Master Control with Wireless Receiver and Built-in Siren.

(2) Rechargeable Back-up Battery x 1

(3) Motion Detector x 1
